In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1838 and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Pearl L. Stenberg of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the managing owner of the Canal Boat Saml P. Oly of Buffalo - which boat is owned by the firm of P. d. Herubury & Co. of Buffalo composed of Charles L. Stenberg, Levi H. Russell and George H. Thymet residents of said Buffalo and Addison Rice and Emitt Clapp residents of the City of New York and that all said firms are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the said Canal Boat Saml P. Oly of Buffalo - whereof Henry Fonda is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester New York in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of S. Bram shipwright - her builder on file in this office -

And J. G. Pullman Surveyor having certified that the said boat or Vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 85 feet 7 inches and her breadth 16 " " " " and her depth 8 " " 9 " " and that she measures 114 tons 84 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal boat has a square stem and no figure head

And the said Pearl L. Stenberg agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N Y. Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 2 day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five.
