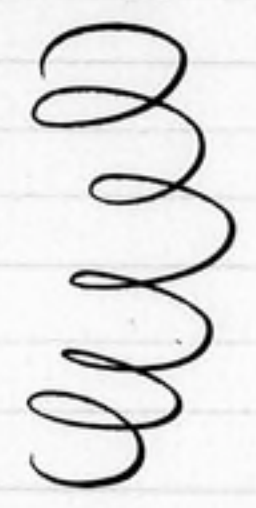

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1828, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Henry Spurr of Buffalo N.Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath, required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat  
Criterion of Buffalo — whereof Albert Mackway — is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester — State of New York — in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of Crane & Knapp, Shipwrights her builders on file in this office

And L. G. Patterson Surveyor — having certified that the said boat — or Vessel has one deck and no masts — and that her length is 95 feet 7 inches her breadth 17 " 0 " her depth 133 " 9 " and that she measures 133 tons 49 — ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat — has a square stem —

And the said Henry Spurr — and no figure — head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat — has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
