In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Wells D. Malbone of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Secretary of the American Transportation Company, a corporation created by the laws of the State of New York and having its principal place of business at said Buffalo - that no foreigner has any interest in the Canal Boat called the "Cleveland" of Buffalo and that said Company is

~~Owner of the Canal Boat~~ sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel called the "Cleveland" of Buffalo whereof J. M. Malbone is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of C. A. Van Slyke & Co. Shipwrights her builders on file in this office

And Phocion Stoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has One deck and no masts and that her length is 93 feet 3 inches her breadth 16 " 9 " her depth 4 " and that she measures 112 tons 65 - ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a square

And the said Wells D. Malbone Secretary &c figure-head agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
