In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th 1852 amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Pearl L. Sternburg of Buffalo N. Y. Managing owner
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Canal boat called the Utica of Buffalo and that said boat is owned by the firm of P. L. Sternburg & Co. of Buffalo composed of said Sternburg and of Levi H. Remmill, J. George H. Bryant of said Buffalo, and of Addison Rice and Everett Clapp of said Buffalo the city of New York, and that all said persons are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Canal boat
Utica of Buffalo whereof said Sternburg is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Utica in the State of New York in the year 1852, as appears by the certificate of David Schurr Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And Francis B. Patterson Surveyor
the said boat or Vessel has one deck
her length is 96 feet 0 inches
her breadth 16 " " 6 "
her depth 6 " " 6 "
and that she measures 917 tons 19
that she is a Canal boat has a square stern ninety-fifths
and no figure

And the said Sternburg
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
