



ENROLLMENT.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and owns one equal undivided half part of the Schooner Robert Bruce of Buffalo and is the Managing owner thereof - that James E. Dalliba who resides at Chicago Illinois owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said said Schooner and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Robert Bruce or Vessel called the whereof George Gaylord

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of

New York in the year 1854, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port May 14th, 1855 No. 65 now surrendered having changed owner

And said Enrollment having certified that

the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that

her length is 123 feet 9 inches

her breadth 26 " 2 "

her depth 11 " 6 "

and that she measures 312 tons 47 ninety-fifths

that she is a Schooner has a round stern - no galleries and a square head

And the said Mortimer Melick and a Seal having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with

the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
