In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same;~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managary owner of the Canal boat called the O. C. Whitney of Buffalo - that said Boat is owned by the firm P. S. Steruberg & Co of Buffalo NY, composed of said Steruberg, Levi H. Runkle & George H. Bryant of said Buffalo and of Addison Rice and Everett Clapp of the city of New York and that all said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal boat or vessel called the O. C. Whitney of Buffalo whereof P. S. Steruberg is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester New York in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of G. Selenee Shipwright, her builder on file in this office is a State of

And Francis G. Pattison Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 81 feet 6 inches her breadth 14 feet 6 inches her depth 8 feet 6 inches and that she measures 93 tons 75- ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat and no figure-head.

And the said Pearl S. Steruberg agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y. having
