In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 26, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

of Buffalo N. Y. whereof Hiram Newton is a

is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Utica State of
New York in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of Messrs Curtis & Neeson
Shipwrights her builders on file in this office and altered from a Canal Boat
into a Schooner at Buffalo New York in the year 1855 as appears by the
Certificate of Patrick Walsh her shipwright on file in this office

And Prudus G. Patterson Surveyor having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that
her length is 95 feet 0 inches
her breadth 16 feet 6 inches
her depth 7 feet 103 inches
and that she measures 103 tons 44 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner (late Canal Boat) has a square stern/
and no figure head.

And the said Oliver Bugbee
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
