## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Chester Hitchcock of Buffalo ~~and~~ Managing owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Propeller Saginaw of Buffalo which boat is owned by the firm of C. Hitchcock & Co of Buffalo, composed of said Hitchcock and Albert F. Dickinson both of said Buffalo, and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel called the Saginaw of Buffalo whereof R. Mayford is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City in the year 1851, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this port April 7, 1854 now surrendered having changed owner

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One mast, and that her length is 15 5 feet 1 inches her breadth 26 feet 0 inches her depth 10 feet 8 inches and that she measures 407 tons 2 3/5 has no Gallies ~~and~~ head.

And the said Chester Hitchcock and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
