In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29, 1850.

Rufus C. Palmer of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is the President of the American Transportation Company a Corporation by and Existing under the laws of the State of New York and that said Company is

~~Citizen of the United States, and sole owner~~ of the Canal Boat or Vessel Called the S. Beeman of Buffalo whereof New York is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, N.Y. in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of Mr. McMichael Shipwright, her builder on file in this office,

And Thos. Hoffman having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has One deck and no mast, and that her length is 94 feet 3 inches her breadth 16 feet 4 inches her depth 6 feet 6 inches and that she measures 94 square tons 62 ninety-fifths stern head.

And the said Rufus C. Palmer and no other person having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
