## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Reuben Dill of Buffalo N. Y. managing owner  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the managing owner of the Brig Robert Burns of Buffalo and owns two equal undivided third parts of said Brig; that Benjamin C. Adams of said Buffalo, Samuel Smith of Malden Mass, Charles P. Chamberlain of Boston Mass; and Parker B. Barry of Boston Mass, each own one equal undivided twelfth part of said Brig, and they all are

Citizen & of the United States, and sole owner of the said Brig called the Robert Burns of Buffalo whereof said Dill is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Port Huron Michigan in the year 1855, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at this Port Aug 3. 1855 - No 171 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 126 feet 1 inch her breadth 27 feet 0 inches her depth 9 feet 10 inches and that she measures 307 tons 10 ninety-fifths and has a no. galley and a scull head.

And the said Reuben Dill agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
