In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Michigan - in the year 1853, as appears by A certified copy of her Certificate of  
Enrollment dated May 29. 1854. No. 68. at Chicago - which copy is surrendered  
the original having been lost.

And said Copy of said Certificate - having certified that  
the said Barque - or Vessel has one - deck and three - masts, and that  
her length is 139 - feet - 8 - inches  
her breadth - 28 - feet - 10 - inches  
her depth - 9 - feet - 5 - inches  
and that she measures 349 - tons 70 - ninety-fifths  
that she is a Barque - has no gallery - stern/  
and no figure - head.
