In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

William Linder of Buffalo N.Y. Managing owner -
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the ~~Empire~~ ~~Steam~~ ~~Ship~~ ~~Brig~~ Cumberland of Buffalo and owns one equal undivided eighth part of said Brig; that William Wibert of said Buffalo owns one equal undivided eighth part of said Brig; that Frederick S. Raymond, James Bradley and Edgar P. Pickering all of said Buffalo each owns one equal undivided fourth part of said Brig; and that all said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Brig Cumberland of Buffalo N.Y. whereof said Raymond is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1844, as appears by her Certificate of Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland Ohio Sept 11. 1854 No. 79 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts masts and that her length is 100 feet 6 inches her breadth 23 feet 6 inches her depth 9 feet 2 inches and that she measures 195 tons 87 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stem and scroll head.

And the said William Linder having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
