## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Amel R. Cobb of Buffalo N.Y. Managing owner  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo aforesaid and is the owner of seven equal undivided one tenth parts of the Barque Mary Stockton of Buffalo. that Andrew Audubon of said Buffalo owns two equal undivided tenth parts of said Barque, and that Richard C. Gunning of said Buffalo owns one equal undivided tenth part of said Barque, and that said owners are

Citizen of the United States; and sole owner of the Barque called the Mary Stockton of Buffalo N.Y. whereof said Gunning is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Manitowish State of Wisconsin in the year 1853, as appears by his Certificate of Enrollment dated at this Port August 9. 1855 - No. 177. now surrendered by reason of a change of ownership -

And said Certificate having certified that the said Barque or Vessel has one deck and three masts, and that her length is 139 feet 8 inches her breadth 28 feet 10 inches her depth 9 feet 5 inches and that she measures 349 tons 70 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a No. gallery and no figure stern head.

And the said Amel R. Cobb agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
