In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Oliver Bugbee - - of Buffalo N. Y. -
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo -
and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Sloop Schooner - - called the
Sea Star of Buffalo N. Y. - - whereof Chas Stevens -
is at present Master; and as he has sworn - -
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving Chart. Co. - - State of
New York - - in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of said Chas Stevens
Superintendent her builder on file in this office -

And Francis G. Pattison Surveyor - - - - - having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two masts, and that
her length is 93 feet 6 inches
her breadth 23 feet 6 inches
her depth 6 feet 2 inches
and that she measures 120 tons 33 ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a Square Stern stern
and no figure head.

And the said Oliver Bugbee
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
