In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, ~~amending the same~~; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

David A. Morse, Rufus R. Johnson, & Charles G. Miller  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that they reside at Buffalo N.Y. and are

Citizen<sup>s</sup> of the United States, and sole owner  $\frac{1}{3}$  part each of the Schooner Lorenzo B. Shepard of Buffalo whereof Charles H. Burrows is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of Messrs. Lawrence Shipwright her builders all in this office 3

And J. Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 118 feet 7 inches her breadth 25 feet 10 inches her depth 10 feet 7 inches and that she measures 396 7 tons 60 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head.

And the said Morse, Johnson and Miller having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
