In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

George W. Patten of Buffalo *MS*
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at ~~Buffalo~~ said Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the North Star of Buffalo whereof James Brown is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of C. A. Vanduyck Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And Phocion Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat Vessel has One deck and no mast, and that her length is 94 feet 11 inches her breadth 17 feet 8 inches her depth 8 feet 11 inches and that she measures 117 square tons 52 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a square stern figure head.

And the said George W. Patten and no having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
