## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

George W. Patten of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or vessel called the R. Riblock of Buffalo whereof Thomas Park is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester State of New York in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of J. C. Patten her builder on file in this office

And Thos. Hoffman Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one deck and no stern her length is 80 feet 4 inches her breadth 13 feet 19 inches her depth 8 feet 16 inches and that she measures 88 tons 9 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a square figure head.

And the said George W. Patten and no figure having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
