In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

William Sutton of Buffalo N.Y. Managing owner

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo that himself, George Davis of Buffalo and H. H. Woolcott of the City of New York each own one equal undivided third part of Canal Boat No. Freeman of Buffalo and that all said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel called the No. Freeman of Buffalo whereof Mr Sutton is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester N.Y. in the year 1851 and appears by the Certificate of J. W. Smith Shipwright, her builder on file in this office

And Francis G. Patterson Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one deck and no mast, and that

her length is 95 feet 6 inches
her breadth 16 feet 3 inches
her depth 7 feet
and that she measures 107 square tons 57 ninety-fifths
that she is a Canal Boat and no figure head.

And the said William Sutton having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
