In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Elias Meed of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the Charles Crook of Buffalo whereof said Elias Meed is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Oswego State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by her last Enrollment dated at the port of Oswego Aug. 11. 1854 now surrendered having changed owners

And says Enrollment the said Sch. or Vessel has one deck deck and two having certified that her length is 20 feet 5 inches mast, and that her breadth is 22 feet 11 inches and that she measures 148 tons 30 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a square stern and scroll head.

And the said Elias Meed and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
