In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester  
New York in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of J. W. Smith  
shipwright her builder on file in this office.

And Francis S. Pattison Surveyor  
the said ~~Canal Boat~~ or Vessel has ~~one~~ deck and ~~no~~  
her length is 96 feet inches  
her breadth 16 feet 6 inches  
her depth 7 feet 4 inches  
and that she measures 109 tons 44  
that she is a ~~Canal Boat~~ has a square stern  
and ~~no~~ head.

And the said William Sutton  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said ~~Canal Boat~~ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
