In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Samuel L. Watson of Buffalo Managing owner
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo
and he and Arion Parkinson of Erie Pennsylvania are



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of 1/2 part undivided of the
Schooner Andrew Scott of Buffalo whereof said Watson
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Erie State of
Pennsylvania in the year 1853, as appears by her last Enrollment-dated at
the Port of Piquette Isle July 19. 1853. No 7. now surrendered,
having changed owners.

And said Enrollment
the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts
her length is 101 feet 2 inches
her breadth 25 feet 3 inches
her depth 8 feet 10 inches
and that she measures 301 tons 86 - ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has a square stern
and clipper head.

And the said Samuel L. Watson
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
