## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Elijah H. Bruce of Buffalo N.Y. Managing owner  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo, and owns two equal undivided third parts of the Schooner, Bay State of Buffalo, and that Merimio Dinnick of said Buffalo owns the remaining one equal undivided third part of said Schooner, and that they are both

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner called the Bay State of Buffalo N.Y. whereof said Dinnick is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1855, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 3d 1855 - Now surrendered, having changed names -
