## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Samuel D. Flagg, of Buffalo N.Y. ---  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y.  
and is a



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Port Boy of Buffalo  
whereof E. Curtis ---

is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Madison --- State of  
Ohio --- in the year 1849, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment  
issued at this Port, dated April 14, 1854, No. 70. Now Surrendered by  
reason of a change of ownership.

And said Certificate ---  
the said Schooner or Vessel has one --- deck and two --- masts, and that  
her length is 73 --- feet --- inches  
her breadth 20 --- feet --- inches  
her depth 7 --- feet --- 5 --- inches  
and that she measures 95 --- tons 24 --- ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner --- has a Square Stern --- stern/  
and --- head.

And the said Samuel D. Flagg ---  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with  
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner --- has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
