In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and ~~"An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same;~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the schooner Eliza Logan of Buffalo and owns the equal undivided one half part of said schooner, that Harrison B. Meixen resides at Conant Ohio and owns the remaining equal undivided half of said schooner and that both said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Eliza Logan of Buffalo whereof William Walker is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of B. B. Jones Shipwright, her builder on file in this office,

And Francis G. Patterson Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is 131 feet 6 inches her breadth 28 feet 1 inches her depth 11 feet 7 inches and that she measures 369 tons 66 square ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner and has a small square stern.

And the said Harvey M. Meixen and William Walker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
