In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

George Davis of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the Managing owner of the Propeller Delaware <sup>of Buffalo</sup> and that he together with William Sutton of said Buffalo and Henry H. Mearns of the City of New York composing the firm of Davis Sutton & Co own the said propeller share and share alike and are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Delaware of Buffalo whereof D. H. Dixon of Watertown NY is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River State of Ohio in the year 1846, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the port of Detroit April 10, 1854 or 26 now surrendered by reason of a change of ownership

And said Certificate the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and One mast, and that her length is 173 feet 11 3/4 inches her breadth 24 feet 3 inches her depth 11 feet 3 inches and that she measures 416 tons 5 1/2 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a round stern and a scroll head.

And the said George Davis agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
