In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "~~An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam~~" passed 7th July 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Samuel J. Holley of Oswego, Oswego County N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Oswego and is the owner of the Schooner *John P. Hall* of Oswego, now and at the date of his purchase thereof lying at the port of Buffalo New York, and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner *John P. Hall* whereof *Thos. D. Tompson* is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1855, as appears by the certificate of *Jacob M. Bantler* of Buffalo N.Y. his builder on file in this office -

And *Phosion Hoffman* Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 138 feet 6 inches her breadth 25 feet 6 1/2 inches her depth 10 feet 10 1/2 inches and that she measures 360 tons 25 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said *Samuel J. Holley* having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
