District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo in the District of Buffalo Creek and is the Managing owner of the Brig Empire State of Buffalo and owns one equal undivided half part of said Brig - that Elijah R Bruce resides at said Buffalo and owns the remaining one equal undivided half part of said Brig - and that said owners are -

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Brig Empire State of Buffalo whereof said Dimick is a

at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment, dated at this port March 31st 1855 or 12 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate she said Brig or Vessel has One deck and two masts, and that her length is 131 feet 11 inches her breadth 29 feet 7 inches her depth 11 feet 2 inches and that she measures 396 tons 67 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig and a square stern sloop - head.

And the said Merrenius Dimick and a square stern sloop - head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
