In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, ~~and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same,~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland Ohio August 21 1850. No h. h. now surrendered having changed owners -

And said Certificate the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 209 <sup>14</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches her breadth 33 <sup>4</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches her depth 12 <sup>43</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches and that she measures 818 tons 40 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a stern head.

And the said Wells D. Walbridge Secretary having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
