In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner - of the Barque E. B. Morgan of Buffalo whereof John Riley is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Grand Rapids - State of Michigan in the year 1867, as appears by a certified copy produced of the last Enrollment of said Barque issued at the Port of Albany - dated April 2^d 1853 No. 21, the original having been withheld by the former owners and the Secretary of the Treasury having decided the issuing new papers without the production of said Barque's last Enrollment: And said copy of said Enrollment - having certified that the said Barque - or Vessel has one deck and three masts, and that her length is 143 feet - 0 - inches her breadth 24 feet - 2 - inches her depth 9 feet - 6 - inches and that she measures 310 - 6 - 6 tons 112 - 6 - 6 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque and has a two galley and no mill or figure head.

And the said Samuel B. Clark having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
