In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Dennison B. Smith of Toledo
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Toledo Ohio;*
And has this day purchased the Schooner called *the Wings of the Wind,* she now being at the Port of Buffalo; that she is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner
whereof *Gerrald Mullen,*
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of
New York in the year *1855,* as appears by the Certificate of
Shipwright her builder on file in this office

And that ~~the said Schooner~~ *P. Hoffman* Surveyor having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has ~~one deck~~ *one deck* and ~~two~~ *two* masts; and that
her length is *138* feet *6* inches
her breadth *26* feet *—* inches
her depth *11* feet *—* inches
and that she measures *370* tons
that she is a Schooner and has a *square* stern
and *no figure* head.

And the said *Dennison B. Smith* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
