



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, ~~and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same~~ as an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Jason Parker of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the managing owner of the Propeller Mount Vernon of Buffalo and owns one equal undivided half part of said Propeller, and that Samuel Morgan of Mohawk Herkimer County N. Y. and Birds eye A. Root of Buffalo New York Copartners doing business under the firm name of Morgan Root are as such copartners the owners of the remaining 1/2 part undivided of said Propeller and they are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Propeller called the Mount Vernon of Buffalo whereof said Parker is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port April 4, 1855 No 14. now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 178 feet 0 inches her breadth 29 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet 8 inches and that she measures 577 tons 77 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller and has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said Jason Parker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
