In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo, and is a

Citizen of the United States and sole owner of the Schooner Calpel Ute  
Sophia Smith of Buffalo whereof he  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the certificate of Vincent B. Dwyer Shipwright one of her builders on file in this office

her length is 137 feet 8 inches

her breadth 28 feet 8 inches

her depth 10 feet 10 inches

and that she measures 357 tons 82 ninety-fifths

that she is a Schooner has a square stern

having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
