



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Edgar P. Pickering of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo
and owns ~~three~~ ^{five} equal undivided parts of the Brig Cumberland
of Buffalo, and that James Beasley of the same place owns the
remaining ~~two~~ ^{three} equal undivided parts of said Brig; and that said
owners are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Brig whereof Mr. Lindsey
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland is a
Ohio in the year 1844, as appears by her last enrollment dated at State of
this Port August 9. 1855 No. 179 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate
the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and 2 masts; and that
her length is 100 feet 6 inches
her breadth 23 feet 6 inches
her depth 9 feet 3 inches
and that she measures 195 tons 87 ninety-fifths
that she is a Brig has a square stern stern/
and a scull head.

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
