



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Paul L. Sternburg of Buffalo N. Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo, and is the President of the Western Transportation Company, a Corporation created by the Laws of the State of New York located at Tonawanda in said District; and that said Company is the

~~Citizen~~ of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller called the Plymouth of Buffalo Tonawanda N.Y. whereof George H. Gibson of Ohio is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1854 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port May 14. 1855 No. 64 now surrendered having changed owners -

And Certificate having certified the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that her length is 212 feet 8 3/4 inches her breadth 32 feet 10 1/2 inches her depth 12 feet 10 1/2 inches and that she measures 846 tons 40 - ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a Square Stern and a well head.

And the said Paul L. Sternburg having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
