



# ENROLLMENT.



## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852 amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Thomas Nelson of Buffalo N.Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a

Citizen - of the United States, and sole owner - of the Schooner called the *Croy* of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cornreant* State of Ohio in the year 1843, as appears by the Certificate of her last enrollment dated at this Port January 24, 1856 No. 5. Now surrenders having changed owners.

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 83 feet 8 1/2 inches her breadth 20 feet 6 inches her depth 7 feet 11 inches and that she measures 122 tons ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a stern head and a roll head.

And the said Thomas Nelson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
