## District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Paul L. Sternburg of Buffalo N. Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is President of the Western Transportation Company, a Corporation created by the laws of the State of New York, located at Tonawanda; and that said company is the

~~Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the~~ Propeller called the  
Mount Vernon of ~~Buffalo~~ whereof James Burnett  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron State of  
Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last  
Enrollment dated at this Port July 4. 1856 No. 1. now  
surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate  
the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that  
her length is 178 feet 11 inches  
her breadth 29 feet 4 inches  
her depth 11 feet 8 inches  
and that she measures 577 tons 77  
that she is a Propeller and has a square ninety-fifths  
stern head.

And the said P. L. Sternburg President  
and no figure  
having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
