District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Abraham Altman & P. Nelson of Buffalo N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that they reside at said Buffalo and each owns one equal undivided fourth part of the Schooner called the Florence of Buffalo, and they are the managing owners of said Schooner; and that Fredricka Stead resides at said Buffalo and owns one equal undivided half part of said Schooner; and all said owners are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner called the Florence of Buffalo N. Y. whereof said Nelson is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port Oct 11. 1855 No. 221 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 87 feet 7 inches her breadth 19 feet 9 inches her depth 7 feet 9 inches and that she measures 119 tons 41 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and a swell head.

And the said Altman & Nelson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
