In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the President of the Western Transportation Company a corporation created under the laws of the State of New York and located at Tonawanda in said District and said Company is the

~~Citizen of the United States~~ and sole owner of the Propeller called the Falcon of Tonawanda whereof N. Woodworth is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Detroit, Michigan in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at Detroit July 16th 1853 No 107 Now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Certificate the said Propeller or Vessel has One deck and one mast, and that her length is 198 feet 10 inches her breadth 29 feet 7 inches her depth 11 feet 7 inches and that she measures 663 tons 84 ninths of a ton that she is a Propeller and has a round stern head.

And the said Paul E. Stenberg Master having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
