



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Elijah H. Bruce of Buffalo State of New York -
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and owns two equal one third parts of said the Schooner "Joy" of Buffalo and *Frank Phillips* who resides at said Buffalo owns the remaining one equal undivided third part of said Schooner and they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Schooner called the *Joy* of Buffalo N. Y. whereof said Bruce is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1852, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March February 22, 1853. No. 12. now surrendered having changed owners.

And said Certificate the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 148 feet 9 inches her breadth 27 feet 3 inches her depth 10 feet 8 inches and that she measures 405 tons 9 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head.

And the said *Elijah H. Bruce* and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
