District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, ~~and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same;~~ also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

John J. Noye of Buffalo N. Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the owner of 1/2 part undivided of the Brig called the "Greyhound" of Buffalo and that George D. Norris & William B. Hibbard of Milwaukee assignees of the Estate of Thomas P. Williams for the benefit of his creditors are the owners of the remaining 1/2 part of said Brig; and they are all

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the said Brig called the "Greyhound" of Buffalo N. Y. whereof said Noye is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Conneaut Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port March 21. 1853 now surrendered having changed owners

And said Certificate of Enrollment the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts; and that her length is 130 feet 11 inches her breadth 28 feet 11 inches her depth 11 feet 11 inches and that she measures 367 tons ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square Stern stern and a Scroll head.

And the said John J. Noye having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
