In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers and lower Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1832, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Charles Williams of Buffalo N. Y. — said Buffalo, having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo, and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner — of the Scow called the Linden, of Buffalo N. Y. whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Vermillion, Ohio, in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at the Port of Sandusky, March 21. 1856. No 1. now surrendered, having changed owners — is a State of

And said Certificate the said Scow or Vessel has one deck and two masts, and that her length is 82 feet 0 inches her breadth 28 feet 11 inches her depth 6 feet 8 inches and that she measures 98 tons 23 ninety-fifths that she is a Scow has a square stern head.

And the said Charles Williams agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Scow has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y. having
