



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Andrew Anderson of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and that Edward Morris & Hugh Mallon reside at said Buffalo and are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner ^{each} of the $\frac{1}{3}$ part undivided of the Schooner August Belmont of Buffalo whereof Hugh Mallon is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of his last Enrollment dated at this Port April 16th 1855, now surrendered having changed Command.

And said Certificate having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has **one** deck and **two** masts, and that her length is **120** feet **9** inches her breadth **21** feet **3** inches her depth **8** feet **7 1/2** inches and that she measures **208** tons **34** ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a stern head.

And the said Andrew Anderson and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
