In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

George Richardson of Buffalo, N. Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and that Hamilton Rainey resides at said Buffalo and they are



Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the ^{each of 1/2 part undivided of the} Schooner "Vermont" of Buffalo whereof said Richardson is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron ^{is a} State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at Sandusky March 22. 1856 No. 3, now surrendered having changed words.

her length is 87 feet 8 inches
her breadth 21 feet 8 inches
her depth 6 feet 11 inches
and that she measures ~~113~~ 113 tons 44 ninety-fifths
