In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo
and is a

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Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Hurricane of Buffalo N. Y. whereof said Foy is

is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port April March 24. 1856 - now surrendered having changed owners. N. Y. 30

her depth 11 feet 0 inches
and that she measures 981 tons 87 - ninety-fifths
