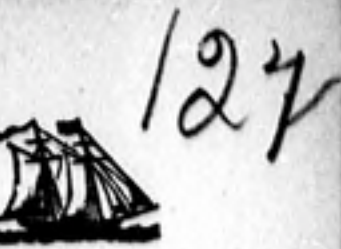




ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Elijah K. Bruce of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the "Petrel of Buffalo" whereof ~~Charles H. Steiner~~ said Bruce is at present Master; and as he has sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo in the State of New York _____ in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this port 30th day of January one thousand eight hundred and fifty four N. 110 now surrendered, having changed owner.

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one _____ deck and two _____ masts and that her length is 113 _____ feet 6 _____ inches her breadth 23 _____ feet 4 _____ inches her depth 8 _____ feet 6 1/2 _____ inches and that she measures 208 _____ tons 71 _____ ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner _____ has a _____ stern and _____ head.

And the said Elijah K. Bruce having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
