In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Paul L. Shruberg of Buffalo N. Y. -
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo and is the President of the Western Transportation Company a Corporation created by the laws of the State of New York located at Tonawanda in said district and is the

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner - of the Propeller called the Banswick
of Boj Tonawanda whereof Thos. Howland is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by the certificate of her last Enrollment dated at this Port Sept 7. 1855. No. 204 - now surrendered having changed owners -

And said Enrollment - having certified that
the said Propeller or Vessel has one deck and one mast, and that
her length is 164 feet 2 inches
her breadth 28 feet 2 inches
her depth 61 feet 9 inches
and that she measures 572 tons 20 ninety-fifths
that she is a Propeller has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said Joshua Maxwell having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
