



ENROLLMENT.



District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Steamships propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

James County of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Sail*
Buffalo and is

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Screw Schooner*
Traveller of Buffalo whereof *W. W. Siggate*
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Port Huron* State of
Michigan in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of his last
Enrollment dated at the Port of *Presque Isle* August
26 1854 No 16. Now named *Haring* changed
name.

And said Enrollment
the said *Screw Schⁿ* or Vessel has *two* deck and *two* having certified that
her length is *95* feet *2* inches mast and that
her breadth *25* feet *5* inches
her depth *8* feet *7* inches
and that she measures *182* tons *28* ninety-fifths
that she is a *Screw Schooner* has a *Square Stern* stern/
and no *Screw* head.

And the said *James County*
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said *Screw Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo, N. Y.**
