District of Buffalo Creek, PORT OF BUFFALO.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on Board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850. And an Act entitled an Act to admit to Register or Enrollment the Schooner *Jadoc Pratt* passed March 13 1856, and the letter of the Secretary of the Treasury of April 14 1856 to the Collector of the Port of Buffalo District of Buffalo Creek, by which the said is instructed to issue a Register or Enrollment as a Schooner, by said Act, *William P. Pick* of Buffalo New York, as having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at

Buffalo aforesaid and that himself and James B. Smith of said Buffalo are

each of 1/2 part and divided of the
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the *Jadoc Pratt* of Buffalo whereof *William P. Pick* is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of *O. C. Spencer* Master Builder his Builder on file in this Office

And *Francis G. Patterson* Mayor of the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and three masts, and that her length is 134 feet 9 inches her breadth 25 feet 8 inches her depth 11 feet 6 inches and that she measures 370 tons 78 ninety-fifths that she is a square stern head. No figure

And the said *William P. Pick* and *Francis G. Patterson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
