In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Henry C. Walker of Buffalo N Y
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo
and is the President of the Lake Navigation Company
a Corporation created under the Laws of the State of New
York and located at Buffalo and that said Company
is the

John M. Standart of Buffalo
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig called the
whereof said Walker
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at
Ohio in the year 1854, as appears by his last Enrollment dated the
Port of Cleveland April 2^d 1856 No 3. Now surrounded having
changed Command.

And said Enrollment
the said Brig or Vessel has One deck and Two having certified that
her length is 145 feet 3 7/8 inches mast, and that
her breadth 29 feet 7 1/4 inches
her depth 12 feet 7 inches
and that she measures 480 tons - 47 - ninety-fifths
that she is a Brig has a square stern/
and a small head.

And the said *Henry C. Walker* President
agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
