In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an act entitled "An act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29 1850.

Olyan R Bruce of Buffalo, N.Y.,
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said acts, and having sworn that he resides at said Buffalo
and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner called the
Niawatha of Buffalo whereof said Bruce
is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo is a
New York in the year 1850, and appears by the certificate of J. W.
Jones shipwright her builder on file in this office

And said Certificate
the said Schooner Vessel has one deck and two having certified that
her length is 122 feet 6 inches mast, and that
her breadth 26 feet 2 inches
her depth 10 feet 6 inches
and that she measures 308 tons 83.
that she is a Schooner has a ninety-fifths
and square stern/
and scroll head.

And the said Olyan R Bruce
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with
the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo, N. Y.
